Scripture Reading: Jeremiah 31-32 Titus 2

Praise the Lord! Let's start of this month with Isaiah 54:17, "No weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and this is their vindication from Me," declares the Lord."

So, by all means stand on this verse when someone or something that you know about is coming against you, but this verse can even apply to things that are happening that you don't know about. Thank God for His protection.

Prayer: Lord, I believe and I stand on the promise of Your protection in Isaiah 54:17 for things I know about and I stand on the promise of Your protection in Isaiah 5:17 for things that I don't even know about. I add my "Amen" of agreement to this promise. Help me to know You are always protecting me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, Who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time, for which I was appointed a preacher and an apostle—I am speaking the truth in Christ and not lying—a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth."

Prayer: Lord, help me to pray and then help me to pray some more. I know that praying for what Your Word tells me to pray for is always right. I pray for those who are in authority and for those who will soon be in authority. I believe You hear and I believe that You answer my prayers. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Verse 13 says, "Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality." I don't think I have to say very much about most of the verses I am giving to you today because they are easily understood. I think someone would have to try to not understand what is being said.

Psalms 19:8 says, "The precepts of the Lord are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the Lord are radiant, giving light to the eyes." We know that God's Word and His ways are always right. And they give us joy. Amen? When we do what they say, we will be blessed. James 1:25 says, "But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do."

Scripture Reading: Jeremiah 46-48 Hebrews 4

Praise the Lord! Romans 12:14 says, "Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse."

Now, before I write to you about this verse let me share with you a verse that Paul wrote in Philippians 3:1, "Further, my brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord! It is no trouble for me to write the same things to you again, and it is a safeguard for you." Paul said it wasn't a bother for him to write the same thing to them more than once and he said it was a safeguard for them and us.

With that in mind, I am going to be like Paul here. Romans 12:14 says, "Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse." I often write to you about being doers of the Word and not hearers only. As a matter of fact, yesterday I gave you James 1:25 that says we are blessed when we do what the Word says.

Hearing and reading the Word (like in these devotions) is good but the blessing comes when we do that it says. Look at 1 Peter 3:9, "Do not repay evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary, bless, for to this you were called, that you may obtain a blessing." This verse says you were called, that you may obtain a blessing. Thank God! Don't miss that this wonderful promise is made right after the Word tells us to *bless* others. So we have several verses today that talk about how we need to bless and not curse our enemies and those who persecute us. Then we are told that we will be blessed when we do these things.

I wonder if I should lead you in a prayer about these things?

Prayer: Lord, please speak to me from Your Word today. Help me to realize if I have been cursing some people that I should be blessing. I want to be a doer of Your Word and I open my life, my words and my thoughts to You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Believe me most of the time people don't need us to try to have all the answers. They need someone to be with them. They need someone to rejoice with them and they need someone to weep with them. They need you.

This might seem like advice that is too simple or too hard but I am just telling what the Word says.

Prayer: Lord, I really do want to be used to help people. Help me to know that I don't need to have all the answers because I don't. Help me to be with people and help me to know my being there is what they need. I also know that when I step out to do what You want me to do You will always be with me and helping me. Scripture Reading: Jeremiah 51-52 Hebrews 6

Praise The Lord! Yesterday, I wrote to you about Romans 12:15 that says we need to **Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.** You probably think I said all that there was to say about that but as you might expect, I have more to say today.

Someone might be thinking something like this: "What if I don't feel like rejoicing with those who rejoice and weeping with those who weep?" Well, not to be to harsh but let me ask you this: "What does your feelings have to do with doing what God wants you to do?"

I can tell you that there have been times when I have rejoiced with people who were rejoicing when I was going through something hard and I didn't feel like rejoicing with them. There have also been times when I have wept with people who were weeping and I didn't feel like weeping with them.

Those are times when we need to be determined to do what God wants and I can assure you that God will help you. A couple days ago we looked at Romans 12:10, "Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another." We are talking about giving preference to those who are rejoicing and weeping because the Word tells us to and because we love them

Anytime we *honor and give preference* to someone else we are laying our feelings down in order to help them.

Prayer: Lord, I know there are people all around who need someone to come along side them. Help me to be willing to give preferential treatment to others. I know that doing these things is right and I know that I can be used by You to bless others when they may need it the most. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Lamentations 1-2 Hebrews 7

Praise the Lord! Romans 12:16 says, "Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited."

Have you ever been around someone who was *conceited?* If you have, you probably weren't as impressed with them as they were with themselves. I just looked up a definition of *conceited* and here is what I found: *excessively proud of oneself; vain.* A conceited person is *excessively proud of themselves.*

I know I started at the end of this verse. Well, we are told not to be conceited. The first part says we should *Live in harmony with one another.* We are told *not to be proud* and we are told to *be willing to associate with people in low positions.* I am sure you can see that a *conceited* person would have a hard time with these things.

Philippians 2:3-4 uses the word *conceit.* "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or *vain conceit.* Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others." I think it is interesting here that *conceit* is referred to as *vain conceit.* When someone is being vain they are focusing on themselves and probably pretty impressed with how wonderful and important they are. They are probably much more impressed with themselves than others are.

The opposite of being conceited and vain is to be humble.

Prayer: Lord, help me to live inharmony with others. Help me not to be proud or conceited. I know how I feel about others when they are full of vain conceit and I wouldn't want others to think of me that way. I also want to be humble. Help me to pray for others if they are having a problem with these things. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Lamentations 3-5
Hebrews 8

Praise the Lord! Romans 12:17 says, "Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone."

Some of the things the Word tells us to do can be difficult. Even as Christians when someone does us wrong we need to avoid falling into the trap of doing evil back to them. I have several Scriptures on this for today.

Proverbs 20:22 says, "Do not say, "I'll pay you back for this wrong!" Wait for the Lord, and He will avenge you." Here is what I hear the Lord saying to me and maybe He is saying the same thing to you. When someone does me wrong I can try to take care of it on my own OR I can trust God to take care of it. Is God speaking that to you? Are there any specific situations He is speaking to about this right now?

1 Peter 3:9 says, "Do not repay evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary, bless, for to this you were called, that you may obtain a blessing." There is something that always stands out to me in this verse. Even when someone does evil to us we are called to bless because we are called to obtain a blessing. You see, the law of sowing and reaping always works and God always wants to bless us. When we sow blessings we will reap blessings.

Galatians 6:7 says, "Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap." 2 Corinthians 9:6 says, "The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully."

Prayer: Lord, thank You for speaking to everyone reading this devotion. Help us to live like You want and help us to sow what we want to reap. I trust You to take care of me way better than I can ever take care of myself. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Ezekiel 1-3 Hebrews 9

Praise the Lord! Romans 12:18 says, "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone."

If I was talking to someone and asked them how this verse would be applied I wonder what kind of answers I would get. I wonder what you would say. We should be people of peace. We know that but the application of that is what I am talking about.

It helps me to read this part of the verse, *If it is possible*. You see, there are times where it isn't possible for us to be at peace with someone because they are not willing to be at peace with us. This verse also says, *as far as it depends on you.* . . I think this is saying that we need to do our part even if the other person or people don't want to be at peace with us. It also stretches me that this verse tells us to do these things *with everyone*. Now you know me. I am kind of a literalist about words like *everyone*. I think it means *everyone*.

Here are some things I do know about applying this verse in our lives. We are suppose to forgive people. Ephesians 4:32 says, "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." We are to forgive others like Jesus has forgiven us.

I also know that the Word tells us to do good to those who hate us. Luke 6:27-28 say, "But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you."

Prayer: Lord, help me to know how to put Your Word into action in my life. I trust You to speak to me about how to apply this truth in my life. I also know that You have always helped me to live for You and I know that You will help me in these things. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! Romans 12:19 says, "Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is Mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord."

This is a wonderful promise. I believe it. How about you? Let's make a declaration based on this verse. "I declare that God is working on my behalf and I trust in Him!"

Proverbs 3:1-6 say, "My son, do not forget My teaching, but keep My commands in your heart, for they will prolong your life many years and bring you peace and prosperity. Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man. Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight."

I love the Word and I know that you do too. These verses from Proverbs 3 are very familiar to me, and yet when I wrote these out for you something stood out to me that I needed to hear. Speaking of the Word we are told to **bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart.** Here is what stood out to me. These are things we are told to do. I can't do them for you and and you can't do them for me, but we can both do them because God tells us to do them and He will help us. We need to *bind and write* the truths about not taking revenge and trusting God to avenge us when it is needed.

Prayer: Lord, I say again, "I declare that God is working on my behalf and I trust in Him!" Help me to bind Your Word to my life and help me to write them on the tablet of my heart. Thank You for speaking to me today from Your Word. I believe it and I am determined to be a doer of Your Word and not a hearer only. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Ezekiel 7-9
Hebrews 10:24-39

Praise the Lord! I want to give you Romans 12:19-20 for today. "Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is Mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord. On the contrary: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head.""

Do you think this is just talking about giving food and water to those who oppose us? There have been times in my life when someone was opposing me and I never saw them hungry or thirsty but I still believe this verse was speaking to me about doing them good. Do you agree?

I know of a situation where a Christian had a person who had done really evil things to them. They had determined that if they ever had the chance to get back at that person, and not get caught, they would pay them back big time. For a while they even determined that they would not forgive that person, but God kept working on them until they forgave them because it was what God wanted them to do. Right after they forgave them, they came across a situation where they could have paid them back big time and no one would have ever known that it was them who did it. But God had worked in their life and because they had forgiven them, they actually helped them rather than hurt them. If it seems like I know a lot of details about this story you might be able to figure out how I could know so much about what happened.

Believe me, walking in forgiveness and doing good is always better than harboring unforgiveness and hurting people.

Prayer: Lord, I choose to forgive my enemies and I choose to do them good, I choose to bless them and I choose to pray for them. I trust You to take care of things that are not my job to take care of. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Ezekiel 10-12

Hebrews 11:1-19

Praise the Lord! We have made it to the last verse of Romans 12. Verse 21 says, "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."

Look at 1 John 4:4, "You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the One who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world." The greater One is in us. Jesus is in us. We can trust Him to take care of us. When some people strike out and fight their own battles it is like they don't know or remember that Jesus knows all about those things. Believe me, He knows and He is able to help us. We need to trust Him.

Philippians 4:19 says, "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus." Now, I know that most of the time people apply this wonderful verse to finances. By all means, Jesus will meet all our needs in that area, but I don't think it is wrong to apply this in other areas as well. After all, if God will meet ALL OUR NEEDS, don't you think that includes protecting us and even fighting our battles for us?

Our part is to bless our enemies, do good to them and pray for them. That is overcoming evil with good.

Prayer: Lord, please help me to remember that You tell me to overcome evil with good. I also ask You to show me how to put that into practice in my everyday life. I know that You are with me and I know that You are well aware of everything I am facing and You even know what I should do. Please empower me to overcome evil with good. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

I heard one preacher covering this verse and he said there were times when he had all kinds of things trying to weigh him down with cares and he would say, "I can't tell you how little I care of those things because Jesus cares for me!"

Prayer: Lord, thank You for the Word. Thank You for speaking to me and reminding me that meditating on Your Word will benefit me. Please help me to pick a verse to meditate on and help me to do it. Go and get strong enough to help them and then be with them and influence them.

Psalms 1:2 says, "But whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on His law day and night." Rather than spending too much time with people who influence you, do what this verse says. Delight in the Word and meditate on it. Doing these things will strengthen you and you will be blessed.
