Scripture Reading: Isaiah 24-26 Ephesians 4

Praise the Lord! I think I will make my comments for today from your reading in Ephesians 4. Verse 1 says, "As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received."

First of all, notice that Paul referred to the fact that he was a prisoner. He was a prisoner for the Lord. Paul had boldly preached the Gospel wherever he went and he was persecuted for all that he did.

Look at what Jesus said to us about times when we are persecuted in Matthew 5:11-12, "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you." Notice that Jesus was talking about times when we face persecution because of Him.

Verse 12 says, "Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you." If we are being persecuted because of Jesus we are in good company and we should rejoice and be glad. Don't miss this. We should rejoice and be glad because great is our reward in heaven. Whenever a person goes through hard things, and persecution is a hard thing, they need to remember heaven. This life and what we face here is not all there is. We are born-again and we are living for Him in this life but this life is not all there is. We are going to heaven and we will be there forever. So no matter what you are going through, rejoice and be glad.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me. I want to live my life worthy of Your calling. I know that You have called me to be a witness for You and I know that is a high calling. Help me to stand for You and Your ways no matter what I face. I also thank You for reminding me about heaven today. Help me to always represent You well. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 27-28 Ephesians 5

Praise the Lord! Continuing in Ephesians 4, verses 2 says, "Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love." What a list. Can you imagine how wonderful it would be if we all lived in line with these things? Well, how about us doing our part?

Look at Colossians 3:12-13, "Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you." I sometimes go through lists like these and talk about each thing listed. This time I want you to read these lists again and ask God if there is anything specific that He wants to talk to you about. (Go ahead and ask God to speak to you and then read these two lists.) Now, if God talked to you about something, know that He is speaking to you because He loves You and He will help you with what He is talking to you about.

Now, there is one part that I do want write to you about. "Forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you." I have shared with many people one on one and in sermons that we need to forgive others. I have said that forgiveness is not an *elective* but it is a *required course*.

Look at what Jesus said in Matthew 6:15, "But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins."

Prayer: Lord, thank You for speaking to me from Your Word. Help me to always listen to what You are speaking to me and help me to live like You want me to live. Help me to forgive like You want me to forgive. I am so thankful for all the forgiveness You have extended to me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 29-30 Ephesians 6

Praise the Lord! If the Word told us to *make every effort* to do something, how do you think we should do what the Word is telling us to do? If you were going to make an *effort* at something I think we would probably know what that meant. It would mean we needed to actually do something and it means that we should probably do something about it sooner rather than later. If we were also determined to make *every* effort, that adds even more to what God is saving.

Well, I have probably written enough about this so let me give you the verse now. Ephesians 4:3 says, "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace." God wants us to be in unity and He wants us to live in peace. So, He tells us to *make every effort* to do those things.

We are in Jesus and other believers are in Jesus too. We should be in unity with one another and we should live at peace with other Christians. Now, I know there are some things that we may disagree with other believers about, but if Jesus is your Lord and Jesus is their Lord then we should *make every effort* to unify around Jesus and we should do whatever we can to live at peace with them.

Romans 12:16-18 say, "Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited. Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone." I have prayed that God will speak to you if there is anyone you need to *make some effort* to put these things into action in your life.

Prayer: Lord, help me to know how I should make every effort to live in unity and peace with other believers. I want to do my part. I also ask You to speak to me if there is anyone that I need to put this truth into action with. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 31-33 Philippians 1

Praise the Lord! Some people hear God speaking to them but they delay too long. The longer they delay the more there is a chance that they won't do what God was asking them to do. Don't be like that.

Ephesians 4:4-6 say, "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, Who is over all and through all and in all."

Look at Psalms 133:1, "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!" God says it is good and pleasant when we live together in unity with other believers. I sure don't ever want to miss out on anything that God says is good and pleasant. How about you? If you have ever been in a situation where God's people were in strife and fighting with each other, I am sure you know that those were not good and pleasant. Don't ever be a part of things like that. Be a person of unity.

Psalms 133 is talking about unity. Look at the rest of Palms 133. Verses 2-3 say, "It is like precious oil poured on the head, running down on the beard, running down on Aaron's beard, down on the collar of his robe. It is as if the dew of Hermon were falling on Mount Zion. For there the Lord bestows His blessing, even life forevermore." When we live in unity, we are where the Lord bestows His blessing, even life forevermore.

Prayer: Lord, I want to live in unity and peace with all believers. Help me to know how to put this into action in my life. I want to be a doer of Your Word and not a hearer only. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 34-36 Philippians 2

Praise the Lord! Ephesians 4:7 says, "But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it." This may be a point that I don't need to make but I feel like I should. When you read that this verse is talking about about something having been given to each one of us, do you realize this includes you?

Each one of us has been given grace. This is a wonderful truth. Look at Ephesians 2:4-5, "But because of His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved." Because of God's great love and grace for you, He saved you by grace.

A couple verses later look at what Paul said in Ephesians 2:8-9, "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast." Again, we are told that we are saved by grace when we put our faith in Jesus. It was not because we worked and earned our salvation. God's grace and our salvation is a gift from God. Jesus died on the cross for us and paid for all our sins that we could not pay for.

Here is another thing that I feel led to show you today. 2 Corinthians 12:9 says, "But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me." God's grace is sufficient for you. When you are weak God will strengthen you because of His grace.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for Your amazing grace. Thank You that Your grace is for me. Help me to know that I am saved by grace and help me to know that Your grace can and will strengthen me when I am weak. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 37-38 Philippians 3

Praise the Lord! I decided to jump from Ephesians to the book of Philippians. I sure love God's Word. It is always available to us and it always speaks to us. Don't you agree? If you do agree then get ready for the Word to speak to you today.

Philippians 4:4-5 say, "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near." God is speaking you to rejoice in Him today and every day. God knows what you are going through and He even knows what is coming your way and He wants you to rejoice in Him, no matter what happens. The Holy Spirit even prompted Paul to say this twice.

Then Paul said that we should let our *gentleness be evident to all.* Does this seem like it ties into our *rejoicing?* It does. When you choose to rejoice, even in hard times, gentleness will be in your life. You won't be raving and ranting about anything. You will be thinking about God and His blessings. You see, when we remember God and His blessing we will always have plenty to rejoice about.

Then Paul ends this verse with these words, **The Lord is near.** Isn't that what we need to remember? Deuteronomy 31:6 says, "**Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you.**" When we know and remember that the Lord is always near and when we rejoice always, we will have confidence and strength. We will be strong and courageous and we will be able to be gentle with others and even with ourselves.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for speaking to me today. I choose to believe You had these truths spoken just for me today. I am going to remember that You are near and I am going to rejoice in Your presence. Help my gentleness to be evident to others. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 39-40 Philippians 4

Praise the Lord! Continuing in Philippians 4, verse 6 says, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." I like reading different versions of the Word from time to time and sometimes I find something that is a real nugget. Here is how one version says the first part of this verse, "Don't worry about anything. Instead pray about everything!" I have often said that if some people would convert their worry time into prayer time they would be prayer warriors.

This verse also tells us this about when we pray. We should pray with **with thanksgiving.** If a person is ever facing things that could cause them to be *anxious* and they know that they should be praying rather than worrying, here is something they would need to do. They would have to think about things that they are thankful for. They would have to focus on God and His goodness more than on the thing that is tempting them to worry and to be anxious.

When we do those things the Word makes us a promise in verse 7. "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." God promises to guard our hearts and our minds in Christ Jesus. He will give us peace that transcends all understanding. Choose to pray rather than worry, God will give you peace. When God gives you peace, embrace it and don't try to talk yourself out of it or try to figure it out. He will give you peace that transcends, and goes way beyond, your understanding. Thank God!

Prayer: Lord, I choose to pray more and to worry less. Help me to remember this truth and help me to put it into practice when I am facing something that is causing me anxiety. I know that Your ways are always right. I also choose to embrace and hold onto the peace that You give me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! We have been covering some wonderful verses in Philippians 4. Believe me when I tell you that God will help you as you choose to be a doer of His word and not a hearer only.

We have been talking about rejoicing more, being gentle, not being anxious, being thankful and holding on to the peace that God gives us. In all these things we have seen that what we focus our thinking on affects everything.

Well, with all that in mind look at Philippians 4:8, "Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things." As we heed God's Word and think about these kinds of things, we will always do better. So, if you are ever in a situation where you know you should be thinking on good things you can turn to this list and it will help you.

We are being told to think on good things. If you want to know how a person is doing at this it is easy to tell. Just listen to what they are saying. In Matthew 12:34 Jesus said that out of the abundance of our hearts a person speaks.

Now let me give you some good advice. Don't take this truth and become like the *word police*. Telling everyone that you can tell them that their thinking is wrong because we hear what they are saying. Don't do that. Listen to your own words and apply this truth to yourself.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for speaking to me from Your amazing Word today. I want to hear and I want to heed everything You are speaking to me. Help me to think on good things and to be thankful. I know that doing these things will produce an abundance in my heart and I know that my words will be good and that they will be life giving. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! Praise the Lord! The book of Philippians was a letter that Paul wrote to the church in Philippi. Paul had preached the Gospel there and started this church. When Paul wrote this book he was now in prison for preaching the Gospel wherever he went. Before Paul was put in prison the Philippians sent him support as he traveled and preached the Gospel.

Now, look at what Paul said in Philippians 4:10, "I rejoiced greatly in the Lord that at last you renewed your concern for me. Indeed, you were concerned, but you had no opportunity to show it." They had evidently sent him an offering and he was thanking them.

Verse 11 says, "I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances." Paul was mentioning these things and thanking them for their support. He wasn't complaining.

Look at this statement, I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. What a statement. Paul was in prison and he was saying that he had learned to be content no matter what was happening to him. Isn't that amazing?

I will have more to say about this as we cover more on this, but for today I am sure we can know that Paul was focusing on more than just what was happening to him in the natural. He was saved, Jesus was with him and people were growing in the Lord. Those things were more significant to Paul than anything else.

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful for the people You have used to help me as a Christian and I bless them now, in Jesus Name. I also ask You to teach me how to be content in You no matter what is happening in my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! Yesterday, we starting reading about what Paul said his attitude was even while in prison. "I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances."

Now, in case someone thinks that Paul might not have been through anything really hard, look at Philippians 4:12, "I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want." He knew about these hard things because he had been through them. He hadn't just read a book about someone else going through them.

In the midst of this list of hard things, Paul wrote this, I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation. Paul referred to what he had learned as being a *secret*. Thank God that He reveals what that *secret* is.

Philippians 4:13 says, "I can do all this through Him who gives me strength." I suppose some people might read that and think, "Well, I already knew that." Some of them might have even memorized this verse or have it on a wall hanging or a bumper sticker. I am not against Scripture memorization, wall hangings or bumper stickers, but I am not sure everyone really knows what Paul referred to as a *secret* here.

God gives strength to those who have learned that having Jesus in their lives is a victory that goes way beyond anything and everything that our circumstances may throw at us. We are victorious *in Jesus*.

Prayer: Lord, please help me. Jesus, help me to know that having You in my life can provide me with a contentment that can't be taken away. I know that with You in my life and that having the strength You give me is the secret to living in victory. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! Paul is still writing to the Philippians who had supported him as he traveled and preached the Gospel. Philippians 4:14-16 say, "Yet it was good of you to share in my troubles. Moreover, as you Philippians know, in the early days of your acquaintance with the gospel, when I set out from Macedonia, not one church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving, except you only; for even when I was in Thessalonica, you sent me aid more than once when I was in need." They had faithfully supported Paul and his ministry.

There is something I want you to see in verse 17, "Not that I desire your gifts; what I desire is that more be credited to your account." Paul wasn't writing these things to get an offering from them. He was pointing out that they were blessed because of their giving. Let me see if I can make this clear because it is important. Paul wasn't thinking about him being blessed. He was pointing out that they were blessed. He referred to their giving being accredited to their account. He wasn't talking about some account he kept. There is an account in heaven and God was going to bless them for their giving.

Look at how Paul referred to their giving in verse 18, "I have received full payment and have more than enough. I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent. They are a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God." Their giving was a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God. Your giving is a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God too.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for what You are showing me from Philippians. I know that You bless me for my giving and I always want to be faithful. I also want to be prosperous so I can bless others even more. I want to be blessed more so I can bless others more. I am sure thankful that I have given my life to You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

We covered many verses before we got to verse 19. Paul wrote to the Philippians and he reminded them that they had faithfully supported him and his ministry time and time again. He also pointed out that their giving had been credited to their account in heaven. Now, Paul said that God would meet all their needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus.

This wonderful promise in Philippians 4:19 was made to givers. I think I could expand on this a little bit and say that the wonderful promise Philippians 4:19 was made to consistent givers.

Look at what Jesus said in Luke 6:38, "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you." This is another wonderful promise, but don't miss who was this promise made to; Those who give will be blessed and those who give generously will be blessed generously.

Prayer: Lord, I love You and I love Your Word. I want to base everything I believe and everything I do on Your Word. I want to hear the Word and I want to be a doer of the Word.
