Romans 2

Praise the Lord! In Ephesians 2 Paul starts off by describing how our lives were before we were saved. Ephesians 2:1-3, "As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our flesh and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature deserving of wrath."

These things describe every one of us before we gave our lives to Jesus. We were dead in our transgressions, we were living worldly sinful lives and we were fulfilling the cravings of our flesh. Because of all those things we were by nature deserving of wrath. Thank God these descriptions weren't the end of the story. Can I get an, "Amen!"?

Ephesians 2:4-5 say, "But because of His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved." Thank God. Have you ever wondered why God saved you? He saved you because of His great love for us. It wasn't because any of us was so wonderful or because we somehow deserved it. We weren't wonderful and we only deserved wrath. BUT GOD LOVED US, HE HAD MERCY ON US AND HE SAVED US. All of this was because of His grace. It is by grace you have been saved. Because of God's grace, Jesus came and laid His life down and paid for our sins so we could be saved.

Prayer: Lord, I know that I was totally and completely lost without You and I know that I am totally and completely saved with You. I am so thankful for Your love, Your mercy and Your grace. I ask You to give me more revelation of how much You love me and how blessed I am to be a Christian. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Romans 6

Praise the Lord! We didn't deserve these things and Ephesians 2:8-9 sure show it. "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast."

Our works could never save us, but for today look at this: It is the gift of God. Here's a quick thought about gifts. They need to be received.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for all the blessing I have as a child of God. I also thank You for all Your kindness towards me. I want to be be quicker to recognize Your kindness and Your blessings. I also want to praise You more for them. I love You and I am so glad I have given my life to You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Romans 7

Praise the Lord! Look at Ephesians 2:10 for today, "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." This is amazing on many levels.

We are God's *handiwork*. Isn't that amazing? When God works at something, do you think He gets the job done? Well, we are His handiwork. He started His good work in our lives and He is going to get it done.

Look at 2 Corinthians 4:6, "For God, Who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made His light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ." Scripture Reading: Psalms 79-81

Romans 8:1-18

Praise the Lord! I hope you are allowing God to speak to you as we go through Ephesians. In the next verses, Paul is going to address Gentiles who were being saved. Ephesians 2:11-12, "Therefore, remember that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth and called "uncircumcised" by those who call themselves "the circumcision" (which is done in the body by human hands) remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world."

Before we were saved we were all lost and without hope because we were without God in the world. We all needed Jesus and thank God we gave our lives to Him. Now we live in the blessings of verse 13, "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ." We are in Jesus. We have been brought near to God by the blood of Jesus.

John 3:16 is probably the best known verse and here it is with verse 17. "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him."

Jesus came to save us. Thank God! We are also told that Jesus didn't come to condemn us. Again I say, Thank God!

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful that You have saved me. I also thank You that I am now in You and I am thankful that there is no condemnation for me because I am in You. Help me to live for You fully and help me to represent You well to others. I want my life to show others how blessed it is to be saved and living for Jesus. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Psalms 82-84

Romans 8:19-39

Praise the Lord! Ephesians 2:14 says, "For He Himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility." Jesus is our peace! Take a moment and say this out loud at least three times, "Jesus is my peace!" (Did you say it out loud?)

You see, we need to believe what the Word says and we need to speak what we believe. 2 Corinthians 4:13 says, "It is written: "I believed; therefore I have spoken." Since we have that same spirit of faith, we also believe and therefore speak." Believe the truth and speak what you believe. We can know that we are believing the truth when we believe the Word.

As for you saying, "Jesus is my peace" look at what Romans 10:17 says, "Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the Word about Christ." Faith comes when we hear the message of God's Word. When you hear the Word preached it will produce faith.

Any way you hear the Word will produce faith. Here's my point. You can even hear the Word by speaking it to yourself. So, when I asked you to say, "Jesus is my peace!" I was encouraging you to do what 2 Corinthians 4:13 tells us to do and I was encouraging you do something that would help you to have more faith according to Romans 10:17.

Here is some more about "Jesus in my peace!". Since we know this is the truth, because it is God's Word, we can know if we have Jesus we have peace. Speaking the truth will help us to settle this wonderful truth in our lives.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for giving me peace. I believe the Word and I believe that You are my peace. Help me to speak this and other truths that You reveal to me through Your Word. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Someone might be thinking: In the days we live how could a person keep their hearts from being troubled and afraid? Believe the Word, speak what the Word says and know that Jesus is with you. He is giving you His peace.

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful that my sins have been forgiven and that I am at peace with You. Thank You, Jesus for giving me Your peace. I believe. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Romans 10

Praise the Lord! Paul has some more to say about the Gentiles being saved. Ephesians 2:14-16, "For He Himself is our peace, Who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, by setting aside in His flesh the law with its commands and regulations. His purpose was to create in Himself one new humanity out of the two, thus making peace, and in one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which He put to death their hostility." Jesus laid His life down for all mankind. All are lost without Him and all can be saved by accepting Him as Lord and Savior. In Jesus there are no divisions. We are all one in Jesus.

There should be no walls of division between any of God's people. We should love each other and we should live in unity. Look at the first part and the last part of Psalms 133. "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity! . . . For there the Lord bestows His blessing, even life forevermore." God wants to bestow His blessing and life forevermore on us. Doesn't that sound good?

Here are some verses that talk about about how important it is for believers to be at peace with each others. Romans 12:18 says, "If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all." Do as much as you can to live peaceably with others. Romans 14:19 says, "So then let us pursue what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding." Pursue what makes for peace and build others up. Matthew 5:9 says, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God." Be a peacemaker. I feel like we need to pray about these things in closing.

Prayer: Lord, help me to live at peace with others. Help me to be a peacemaker. I want to build others up and to be in unity with all my brothers and sisters. I ask You to speak to me about anywhere I need to do these things. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Psalms 99-102

Romans 13

Praise the Lord! Ephesians 2:21-22 say, "In Him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. And in Him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by His Spirit." I have been emphasizing our being *in Jesus*, and all that is true, but these verses add more.

We are *in Jesus* personally and we are *in Jesus* together with all Christians. We are *joined together*. *In Him* we are **are being built together**. We are all in Jesus and we need each other.

Look at Matthew 16:18-19, "And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

I know Jesus spoke this to Peter first but it certainly has application in our lives today. Jesus is *building His church*. Isn't that Good News? It is surely Good News to me as a Pastor. It is also true that Jesus is building us as individuals but don't ever miss out on the fact that He is also *building His church*.

The church that Jesus builds has power and authority. We have the keys to the kingdom. What we bind on earth will be bound in heaven and what we loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for working in my life. I also know that You are working in everyone in Your church. Help us to be joined together and help us to become a holy temple in You. I ask You to bless my local Church. Help us to grow together and help us to be powerful for You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Jesus healed these people and it says He did that to fulfill what was spoken: He took up our infirmities and bore our diseases.

Now, I want to say something that I may need to explain. Jesus heals all of His people! Think about this: All Christians go to heaven and are there any sick people there? No because they are all healed. Now look at what Jesus told us to pray for in Matthew 6:9-10, "This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your Name, Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

Prayer: Lord, thank You for revealing Your will for my healing in the Word. I pray for Your kingdom to come and for Your will to be done on earth just as it is in heaven. I choose to believe as I remember all Your benefits. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

They probably aren't talking about a person being in a literal hole in the ground but they are still in the pits and God still wants to help them.

So, if you are ever in a pit or in the pits here are some verses to give you hope. In Job 33:18 the Word says this, "To preserve them from the pit, their lives from perishing by the sword." God can and will preserve you from the pit. Job 33:28 says, "God has delivered me from going down to the pit, and I shall live to enjoy the light of life." God can and will deliver you from the pit so you can enjoy the light of life. Want to say, "That's for me!"?

The next verse is the one we started with in Psalms 103. Then Isaiah 38:17 says, "Surely it was for my benefit that I suffered such anguish. In Your love You kept me from the pit of destruction; You have put all my sins behind Your back." God keeps us from the pit of destruction. Lastly, Jonah 2:6 says, "To the roots of the mountains I sank down; the earth beneath barred me in forever. But You, Lord my God, brought my life up from the pit."

Prayer: Lord, I thank You for all Your benefits and I don't ever want to forget them and I don't ever want to doubt them. Thank You for delivering me from the pit. I know that You are always with me and I know that I will never be separated from Your love and care. I love You! In Jesus' Name, Amen.

They became stiff-necked and in their rebellion appointed a leader in order to return to their slavery. But You are a forgiving God, gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love. Therefore You did not desert them." These people were turning away from God but He didn't desert them. Thank God that He is slow to anger.

Prayer: Lord, I love You so much. Thank You for all that You are and thank You for never changing. I thank You that You crown me with love and compassion. Thank You that You are slow to anger and thank You so much that You have never deserted me and I know that You never will desert me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Our part is to believe and to speak what we believe. 2 Corinthians 4:13-14 say, "It is written: "I believed; therefore I have spoken." Since we have that same spirit of faith, we also believe and therefore speak, because we know that the One who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead will also raise us with Jesus and present us with you to Himself."

Prayer: Lord, I believe and I speak that You are working righteousness and justice for me. I commit my ways and plans to You and I know that You will work things out for my benefit. Thank You for speaking to me from Your Word again today. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

That is an amazing truth and there is a truth in this for us. God loves you and He saved you by grace. Thank God for His grace. Now, think about this: Paul was certainly saying that He was saved by grace but he also said that God's grace was given to him for others. When you think of all that God has done for you realize that He did those things for you and He wants you to share them with others.

Here's an example. God saved you. Thank God. We are completely lost with out Him and we are completely saved with Him. Now God wants you to help others to be saved too. You are not just saved for yourself. We are saved to help others to be saved. Matthew 5:16 says, "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me. I want to help others to be saved. I don't ever want to miss out on anything You have for me to do. Help me to know that the wonderful things You have done for me are for me and they are for me to share with others. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Verse 6 says, "This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus."

God wants everyone to be saved. He wants the Jews and the Gentiles to be saved and we are all saved by accepting Jesus as our Lord and Savior. There is no difference between Jews and Gentiles. We are all lost without Jesus and we are all saved when we accept Him as our Lord and Savior.

Now, I know that the issue of Jews and Gentiles may not be a big issue in our lives today, but we do need to know that Jesus wants to save everyone today just like He did back then. Don't let prejudice about anything or anyone deceive you into thinking anything else. God loves the world and Jesus came to open up salvation to all who will accept Him.

Prayer: Thank You for saving me and thank You for providing salvation to all who will accept You. Help me to never think anyone cannot be saved. I know that we are all lost without You. Help me to share the good new with everyone. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for coming and laying Your life down for the sins of the whole world. Thank You for saving me when I turned my life over to You. It was a miracle. Help me to know that there are others who are just one miracle away from being saved. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Lastly this verse, that has a lot to say to us, tells us that God is working in our lives with His power. God wants to use you but not in your own strength. God's power is working in and through you.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for Your Word. I am so thankful for all that You have spoken to me though Your Word and I want to always be open to You speaking even more to me. I know I am saved by grace and I want to be faithful share Your grace with others with Your power. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

And Proverbs 16:18, "Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall." And Proverbs 29:23, "Pride brings a person low, but the lowly in spirit gain honor."

Paul was certainly used by God in mighty and powerful ways but he didn't fall into pride. Ephesians 3:8 says, "Although I am less than the least of all the Lord's people, this grace was given me: to preach to the Gentiles the boundless riches of Christ." Paul was an apostle but he didn't say that he was less than all the other apostles. He said that he was less than the least of all the Lord's people. That is humility. He knew that he was saved by grace and anything God did for him and through him was all because of God's grace.

This grace was given me: to preach to the Gentiles the boundless riches of Christ. God could use Paul in mighty ways because he was humble. Look at what Peter wrote about our need to be humble and what he said God will do when we are humble. I Peter 5:6 says, "Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that He may lift you up in due time."

When we humble ourselves under God's mighty hand, it is not the end. It is the beginning. In due time, He will lift you up. I have observed that some people who are humble have a hard time accepting that their due time has come and that God is now lifting them.

Prayer: Lord, I certainly know that I am saved and kept in You by grace. I am humbled by how much You love and bless me. Help me to never allow pride in my life. I want to stay humble and when You choose to use me more I want to do all that You have for me to do in humility. I trust every aspect of Your work in my life. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

Scripture Reading: Psalms 136-138 1 Corinthians 9

Praise the Lord! Look at what Paul said in Ephesians 3:8-9, "Although I am less than the least of all the Lord's people, this grace was given me: to preach to the Gentiles the boundless riches of Christ, and to make plain to everyone the administration of this mystery, which for ages past was kept hidden in God, Who created all things."

God called Paul to preach and to make plain to everyone something that was a mystery. As New Testament believers we know things that were a mystery to Old Testament people. Here are some examples: God loves us. He wants us to be saved. He wants us to be His children. God sent Jesus to die on the cross for our sins so our sins could be forgiven. And here's another big thing. God wants all people to be able to be saved.

Having said all that here is what I want to emphasize for you today. God wanted Paul to *make these truths plain*. God wants truth to be understood so we can accept it and have all that He has promised us. Some people seem to make things complicated and hard to understand. That was not what God wanted in Paul's day and He wants His truths to be understood today.

So, if there are people that are speaking into your life that are helping you understand God's Word and His ways, be thankful for them. Make sure everything they teach is based on the Word and, as I often say, believe the Word. Colossians 1:26 says, "The mystery that has been kept hidden for ages and generations, but is now disclosed to the Lord's people." We are blessed.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for revealing truth to me. Thank You, Holy Spirit, for teaching me and for leading me into more and more knowledge of God and His ways. I don't ever want to miss what You have for me and I want to believe all that You reveal to me. Thank You for all Your work in my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Those things are revealing the goodness of God. They reveal God's love and grace. So, live for Him, be blessed and let your life be an example for all to see.
