Scripture Reading: Isaiah 22-23

Ephesians 3

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 24-26 Ephesians 4

Proverbs 10:19-21 say, "When words are many, transgression is not lacking, but whoever restrains his lips is prudent. The tongue of the righteous is choice silver; the heart of the wicked is of little worth. The lips of the righteous feed many, but fools die for lack of sense."

Prayer: Lord, please help me to speak words of life. I thank You for teaching me Your Word. I want to keep learning and I want to speak words of life. Help me to realize it if I start to speak things that are unwholesome and help me to stop. Help me to speak life and help me to never ever grieve the Holy Spirit. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 27-28 Ephesians 5

God sent Jesus. He loved us that much. "How will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?" None of have ever needed anything as much as we needed Jesus. God met that need and He promises to graciously give us ALL things. Thank God for His amazing grace.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for choosing me and thank You for saving me. I also thank You for working in my life and for teaching me more and more wonderful truths from Your Word. Thank You for showing me that You have met my need for salvation and for telling me that You will graciously give me all things. I choose to believe. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 29-30 Ephesians 6

Praise the Lord! In case you haven't noticed we are looking at some of what Paul wrote in Romans 8. Verse 33 says, "Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies."

Who will bring any charge against us? The devil will. We need to remember that he is a liar and he only speaks lies. Look at what Jesus said in John 8:42-44, "Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I have come here from God. I have not come on My own; God sent Me. Why is My language not clear to you? Because you are unable to hear what I say. You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies."

Jesus always spoke the truth. These people were arguing with Him. They were on the devil's side. Jesus revealed a lot of truth about the devil in these verses and we need to know them and we need to remember them.

The devil was and always will be a murderer. There is no truth in him. Lies are his native language. He is a liar and he is he father of all lies.

Jesus revealed these things to us. Now, knowing these things, what do you think we can know about anything the devil says? They are all lies! If the devil tells you that you are going fail or die, you can know that those things are lies.

Prayer: Lord, I know that You always speak the truth and I know that the devil always lies. I choose to believe everything You speak to me and I choose to reject everything the devil says. I choose life. I choose truth. Thank You for revealing the truth to me. I am so thankful that I have given my life to You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 31-33 Philippians 1

Praise the Lord! Romans 8:34 says, "Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us." There is sure a lot for us to cover in this verse.

Who is the one who condemns? The devil! Now please don't think I am contradicting what the Word says here. We are not condemned, but the devil, who always lies, tries to put condemnation on us.

Thank God that He never condemns us. Look at John 3:17, "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him." I know this is a very familiar verse and I am sure you know it well, but don't ever lose the significance of what it is saying. Let me state some things personally. Take them for yourself and your life.

God loves you so much that He sent Jesus to pay for your sins so you could be born-again, forgiven and adopted into His family. You are now *in Him* and you shall *never perish*. You have *eternal life now and forever*.

God didn't send Jesus to condemn you. He sent Jesus to save you. God has no condemnation for you. Jesus paid for it all. Romans 8:1-2 say, "Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death."

Prayer: Lord, thank You for paying for everything that separated me from You. Thank You for dying for my sins and for saving me. I believe that I am free from condemnation. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Philippians 2

Paul prayed that we would know the hope that we have in Jesus and that we might know that resurrection power is at work in our lives. Don't miss this: The resurrection power that is at work in your life is the same resurrection power that raised Jesus from the dead!

That is amazing and there is more. Jesus is now at the right hand of God and interceding for us.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me with resurrection power. Thank You that it was the same resurrection power that raised Jesus from the dead. Thank You for continuing Your good work my life and thank You for praying for me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

GOD is with you and He will always help you. Does that give you confidence?

There is always more for us to learn.

Well, look at Romans 8:37-39, "No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Paul was *convinced* that God would do what He promised. How do you think this should affect how we live? Look at what Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 15:58, "Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain."

Stand firm and don't let anything move you. Give yourself to the work God has for you to do. Know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain. Galatians 6:9 says, "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up." Don't be weary and don't give up. The harvest is coming. God keeps His promises!

Prayer: Lord, thank You so much for all that You have helped me to settle in my life and please help me to keep learning more and more. I am never going to give up. I know that there is nowhere else for me to turn and I don't even want to think about giving up. I love You! In Jesus' Name, Amen.

When we hear the Word and put it into practice in our lives we will be built on a firm foundation that will not be shaken no matter what happens. John 13:17 says, "If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them." Are you getting the point? One more and then we will pray. James 1:25 says, "But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do."

Here is something that always stands out to me from this verse: We need to **Be Still.** When a person is panicking and fretting they probably aren't being still. Here is what I have learned that helps in times like that. I need to take my focus off the problem and put my attention on Jesus.

Colossians 3:1-2 say, "Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things." We are the ones who determine what we set our minds on. A person can set their mind on the problems and the things that are distracting them OR they can set their mind on Jesus, the Word and all that He has done for us. Believe me, I have learned that setting my mind on Jesus and the things above are always what I need to do. Let's pray about this now.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for speaking to me today. Help me to be still and to know that You are God. I know that You love me and I know that You have always helped me. Help me to set my mind on things above and to set my mind on You, Your love and Your care for me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 48-49 Colossians 4

Praise the Lord! I have written devotions like this for over 40 years. As I write them I am always looking for things to cover. Sometimes I go through sections verse by verse, sometimes something I have recently read are what I feel like I should cover. I just try to be led.

For today I noticed that Colossians 4 is part of your Scripture Reading for today and so turned to it in my Bible and I decided to cover some of those verses.

Colossians 4:2 says, "Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful." I just looked the word *Devote* on a dictionary on my computer. Here is what it says: Devote - To give all or a large part of one's time or resources to a person, an activity, or to a cause. With that definition in mind, Paul said we should *devote ourselves to prayer!*

With that in mind, I hasten to remind you what Jesus said will happen when we pray. Matthew 7:7-8 say, "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." Asking, seeking and knocking are talking about prayer and Jesus says that when we pray He will answer.

I even underlined an important truth in these verses. These promises are **For everyone**. Actually, I should probably add a little to that statement. These promise are **For everyone who prays**. Does this motivate you to *devote yourself to prayer more?*

Prayer: Lord, thank You for speaking to me, and everyone else doing this devotion, about praying. Help me, and everyone else doing this devotion, to devote ourselves to pray and help us to know that You will answer our prayers. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! When we covered Colossians 4:2 yesterday, Paul encouraged those he wrote to, and us, to devote ourselves to prayer. Now, look at verse 3, "Pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains."

Paul expected them to pray. I hope we are all praying more too. Thank God that He always speaks to us from His Word, but know this: the blessings come when we *do what He speaks to us.*

Look at what James said in James 1:25, "But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do." The blessing comes when we do what God speaks to us.

So, as we hear God speaking to us from the Word and when we put it into practice we will be blessed. That is good and I want you to know that Paul also believed that he would be blessed too. You see, he wanted them to pray for him to have open doors for the Word and he believed God would answer their prayers.

Paul even referred to being in chains. He was in prison for preaching the Gospel and yet he kept preaching the Gospel there and writing letters like Colossians. Paul might have been in chains, but the Gospel was still being shared and people were still being impacted. When we are devoted to prayer, God will answer our prayers too. Keep praying. Don't quit.

Prayer: Lord, I thank You for speaking to me about praying more. I want to be faithful to do what You ask me to do. I want to pray more. I know that praying will be good for me and I know that praying will be good for those I pray for. Help me to pray! In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 53-55 1 Thessalonians 2

Praise the Lord! Paul wrote some more about what he wanted prayer for. Colossians 4:4 says, "Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should." Paul knew that he was called, by God, to preach the Gospel and he was surely doing that. It is evident he also knew that prayer would help. Are there things that you know you should be doing and you might already be doing those things but you also know that prayer would help? Prayer always helps.

Colossians 4:5 says, "Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity." Now Paul is writing to them about how to live for Jesus. We should be wise. The more wisdom we have from God the better we will do. As we have wisdom, we need to let it affect how we live. Wisdom should affect how we act around others. We should always be ready to speak what God wants and we need to remember that the way we live is a witness even if we don't say anything. On person prayed, "Lord help me to share the Gospel all the time by what I say and by how I live." Look at what Paul wrote in Ephesians 5:15-16, "Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil."

Paul said we should *make the most of every opportunity.* As you are faithful to live like this I can assure you that God will give you more opportunities. Look at what Jesus said in Mathew 5:16, "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." Let your light shine when you have opportunities to *say* something and let your light shine through the way you live.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me. Help me to be a good witness for You. I also thank You for all the wisdom You have given me. Help me to renew my mind to Your Word and help me to share Your wisdom with words and help my life to be a good example of how a Christian should live. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Paul was talking about believers who had died and he wanted to make sure they understood how all this ties in to what Jesus said. He was informing them of the truth and helping them. These things will help us too.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for preparing a place for me and for all Christians to be with You in Heaven. I know that giving my life to You was the best decision I ever made. Help me to share the Good News with others so more and more people can be saved. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Since this verse talks about your inheriting all this I have been showing you other verses in Revelations that talk about things that we will inherit in Heaven. I am sure there are many more things but we are looking at the things that are mentioned in the book of Revelations.

Revelations 3:12 says, "The one who is victorious I will make a pillar in the temple of My God. Never again will they leave it. I will write on them the name of My God and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which is coming down out of heaven from My God; and I will also write on them My new Name."

Did you notice there sure seems to be a lot of *writing* going on in this verse. Rather than talk about those things individually I want to make a larger point. We belong to God! He knows we belong to Him and He is making it clear. Also, He will never quit having us as His people. He paid a high price for us to be His. He sent Jesus to pay for everything that needed to be paid for us to be forgiven, made new and so we would belong to Him.

In the book of Revelation the anti-christ is going to try to make everyone get a mark. Revelation 13:16, "It also forced all people, great and small, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hands or on their foreheads." We are marked by God!

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for making me victorious in You. I also thank You for all the truth You are showing me from Your Word. I know that I belong to You and nothing is ever going to change that. Help me to have the confidence that all these thing are true. I am not going to be distracted or derailed from living fully for You now and forever. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

So, here's some more. Revelations 3:21 says, "To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to sit with Me on my throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with My Father on His throne."

Now, before I write about this I want to remind you that we are <u>victorious</u> because Jesus has made us <u>victorious</u>. We could have never been <u>victorious</u> on our own. Jesus won the victory for us.

This verse also says: I will give the right to sit with Me on my throne. Praise God! Isn't that amazing? It gets even more amazing. I will give the right to sit with Me on My throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with My Father on His throne. We are seated on Jesus' throne with Him and He is seated on the throne with the Father and we are seated there too. Praise God!

Look at Ephesians 2:4-7, "But because of His great love for us, God, Who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved. And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, in order that in the coming ages He might show the incomparable riches of His grace, expressed in His kindness to us in Christ Jesus."

Thank You for saving me and for keeping me safe. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
