Scripture Reading: Psalms 148-150 1 Corinthians 11:16-34

Praise the Lord! If you were doing last month's devotions you know we are working our way straight through the book of Ephesians. We finished off yesterday with Ephesians 3:13 which says, "I ask you, therefore, not to be discouraged because of my sufferings for you, which are your glory." Paul was boldly proclaiming the Gospel wherever he went and there were people who opposed his message and him personally. He was persecuted in many ways. Look at what he said to these believers who knew about his persecution. He told them not to be discouraged.

Look at what Joshua said in Joshua 1:9, "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." Being courageous is the opposite of being discouraged. I want to give you some more from Ephesians, but right now I feel like some of you need to be encouraged to be courageous and to avoid being discouraged. Someone might be thinking, "If you knew what I am going through you would know why I am discouraged." Well, don't miss what Joshua said at the end of Joshua 1:9, "The Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." God is with you and He will never leave you. Receive the encouragement that He has for you.

Deuteronomy 31:8 says, "The Lord Himself goes before you and will be with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged." God will never forsake you, He will be with you AND He even goes before you. Praise God. Be encouraged and be courageous.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for speaking to me today. I know that You are always with me and I know that You will never leave me. I choose to be encouraged and I choose to be courageous. I also pray for all my brothers and sisters that they will be encouraged and courageous too. Thank You for hearing and answering all our prayers. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

## Scripture Reading: Proverbs 1-2 1 Corinthians 12

Scripture Reading: Proverbs 3-4 1 Corinthians 13

Praise the Lord! Ephesians 3:16-17, "I pray that out of His glorious riches He may strengthen you with power through His Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love..."

Prayer is powerful. Paul didn't just tell us to pray. He prayed himself. He prayed for God to *strengthen us with power through the Holy Spirit*. Thank God that He answers prayer and thank God for the Holy Spirit.

Look at what John 16:13 says about the Holy Spirit, "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on His own; He will speak only what He hears, and He will tell you what is yet to come." Jesus spoke these things.

Jesus said the Holy Spirit would guide us into all truth, that He would speak what God has for us and that He would even tell us what is yet to come. Thank God for the Holy Spirit.

Paul also prayed that we would be *rooted and established in love*. 1 John 4:7-8 say, "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love." God is love and we should love one another. When we love each other, like we should, we show that God is in our lives.

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful that You saved me and I know that You saved me because You loved me. Thank You for giving me the Holy Spirit. Holy Spirit, I ask You to guide me into all truth, to speak to me and to even show me things to come. I choose to love my brothers and sisters in You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

What else would we ever rely on if not Him and His love? Look at the last part of these verses: God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them. We have hope. Romans 5:5 says, "And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, Who has been given to us." Thank God for His amazing love.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for revealing the Good News of the Gospel to me and giving me the faith to give my life to You. Thank You for loving me. I rely on Your love. I have hope now because I have You in my life. I also know that Your love is being poured into my heart by the Holy Spirit. Help me to live and to love like I should as Your child. Scripture Reading: Proverbs 7-8 1 Corinthians 14:21-40

Praise the Lord! Look at this part of Paul's prayer in Ephesians 3, "And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ." Paul prayed that we would have the power to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ.

Look at what is recorded the Old Testament in Psalms 103:11-12, "For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His steadfast love toward those who fear Him; as far as the east is from the west, so far does He remove our transgressions from us." God's steadfast love is higher and greater than the heavens are above the earth. And we are told that He has *steadfast love for us.* That means God loves us and He will never stop loving us. Can you say, "Thank You, Jesus!"?

Then these verses give us an example of how great God's steadfast love for us is. *God removes our sin from us as far as the east is from the west.* Hebrews 8:12 says, "For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more." When God forgives your sins He will never remember them. This might be hard, or even impossible, for us to grasp but it is the truth of God's Word. We need to choose to believe it.

Ephesians 1:7-8 say, "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that He lavished on us. With all wisdom and understanding." Jesus shed His blood so we could be forgiven. Thank God for His amazing grace.

Prayer: Lord, please give me power to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ. I know that I was completely lost without and You and I know that I am completely saved with You. Thank You for Your amazing grace. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Proverbs 9-10 1 Corinthians 15:1-32

## Scripture Reading: Proverbs 13-14 1 Corinthians 16

Praise the Lord! The book of Ephesians has two major parts. Chapters 1-3 talk about wonderful things that God has done for us and chapters 4-6 talk about how we should live in light of what God has done for us.

Ephesians 4:1 says, "As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received." First of all, Paul points out that he was in prison when he wrote this book. When Jesus saved Paul He called him to go and preach the gospel. Paul faithfully did what God wanted and some people hated Paul and his message. They opposed him and they ended up throwing him in jail for preaching the gospel. Paul kept living for Jesus and reaching out to people in any way he could. While there he wrote Ephesians. Here's a quick point: Paul never quit what God wanted him to do. He did it when he was free to travel around and he did it when he was in prison.

Now in chapter 4 Paul starts writing about how we should live in light of what God has done for us. I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. Thank God we are saved. We are saved because Jesus paid for our sins so we could be bornagain and adopted into the Kingdom of God. Now, we need to live like God wants. Paul even says we have been called. I know this makes some people nervous, but you were called to be saved, you accepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior and now you are called to live for Him.

We will cover how this applies in our lives as we go on but for now know that God has a plan for you and it is a good plan. He will also help you to live like He wants you to live. Can you say, "Thank You, Jesus!"?

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for having a plan for my life. Help me to know how I should live and what I should be doing. I also thank You so much for always helping me as I live for You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

I have to tell you there is more to come but for today, Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

We are to be *completely humble*. I am sure you know that Jesus is the source of everything good in your life. So, be humble and make sure Jesus gets all the credit.

Then we are told to be *gentle*. Have you ever been around someone who was gentle? Have you ever been around someone who was not gentle? Which person did you like better? Be like the gentle one and people will like you.

Then we are told to be *patient*. Who should be you be patient with? Everyone, including yourself.

Bearing with one another in love. Thank God that He loves us and we should love others. Look at 1 Corinthians 13:7, "Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things." Did that talk about all things four times? Do you get the point?

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful that I have given my life to You and I am thankful that You are working in my life. I know that Your work in my life is right. Help me to be completely humble, to be gentle, and to be patient and to bear with everyone. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Proverbs 17-18 2 Corinthians 2

Praise the Lord! In Ephesians 4:1, Paul urged us to live a life worthy of the calling we have received. I feel like offering a prayer up right here, "Thank You for calling me and for saving me. Help me now to live like I should. In Jesus' Name, Amen."

Ephesians 4:3 says, "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace." We need to be in unity and to be at peace. Look at 1 Corinthians 1:10, "I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment."

God always blesses unity. Look at the first and the last part of Psalms 133, "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity! . . . For there the Lord bestows His blessing, even life forevermore." God's blessings are poured out when we are in unity.

Look at what Jesus said in John 13:34-35, "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another."

We should love one another. This verse makes it even more powerful when it says that we should love one another **as I have loved you.** That is a high standard. Jesus also told us that the world will know that we really are His disciples when we love one another.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for helping me to keep growing in You and Your ways. I see from the Word that unity is powerful. Help me to choose to live in unity with my brothers and sisters. I also want my love for others to be a witness that I am really Yours. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Proverbs 19-20 2 Corinthians 3

Praise the Lord! Ephesians 4:4-6 say, "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, Who is over all and through all and in all."

I don't think I have ever thought about how many times the word *one* is used in these verses. *One* is mentioned seven times. I am not going to go through each of them and comment on them, but I do want to say that I think all these *ones* speak to the unity we have in Jesus. I am aware that divisions happen in the body of Christ, but that isn't God's best. We are *one* in Jesus.

Look at verse 7, "But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it." Each *one* of us has been given God's grace. Thank God for His Amazing Grace. Since we have been given grace we should extend grace to each other.

Look at what Peter wrote in 1 Peter 4:8-10, "Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms." We should love each other, forgive people when they need it, be hospitable to others and use whatever giftings we have to serve them. Peter also made the point that we should do these things as faithful stewards of God's grace.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me by grace. Help me to know how to show grace to others. I know that You want all of Your people to love each other and I want to do my part. Help me to know how to apply this truth in the situations I find myself in. I thank You in advance for helping me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Proverbs 21-22 2 Corinthians 4

Praise the Lord! Ephesians 4:8-10 say, "This is why it says: "When He ascended on high, He took many captives and gave gifts to His people." (What does "He ascended" mean except that He also descended to the lower, earthly regions? He who descended is the very One who ascended higher than all the heavens, in order to fill the whole universe.)"

These verses are talking about what happened right after Jesus died on the cross for our sins. He descended in death and then He ascended because death, hell and the grave could not hold Him. He died for our sins and when they were all completely paid for He rose from the dead and He is alive forever more. Our sins have been paid for and we now have eternal life in Jesus. These verses also refer to Jesus giving gifts to His people.

Look at the next verse, "So Christ Himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers." These are called the five-fold ministry gifts and they are gifts from Jesus. They are good gifts. The next verse tells us why they were given. "To equip His people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up." These five-fold ministry gifts were given, by Jesus, to serve us and help us to be built up. God only has good gifts for us and the five-fold ministry gifts are good. The next verse tell us how long we will have these gifts from God. "Until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ." The five-fold ministry gifts are to build us up and grow into the unity of faith.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for dying on the cross for the sins of mankind. I am so glad that I have given my life to You. I also thank You for the ministry gifts that You have given to help me to grow into maturity and to reach the unity in the faith. Help me to receive and respect the gifted men and women You have given to help me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Look at what Jesus said to some people who believed in Him. John 8:31-32, "To the Jews who had believed Him, Jesus said, "If you hold to My teaching, you are really My disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." Jesus wanted them to know the truth and He knew the truth would set them free. Jesus wants us to know the truth and He knows that the truth will set us free too. We are so blessed to be able to study God's Word every day and we are blessed to have five-fold ministers who will help us to grow to maturity. We are so blessed. Keep growing.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for helping me to grow and to become mature. I know that Your plan for my life is right and good. Some of the things He supplies us with are the Word, teachers to reveal the truth of God to us and anything else we need. All these things, and more, are supplied to us because God loves us. I didn't write the end part of this verse out and I want to add it now. The whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work. We all play a part in growing and in helping others to grow. As each part does its work we grow. We need each other.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for all the growth I have made. I know that You want me to keep growing and I want that too. Help us all to do our part so we can all grow. I thank You for the people that have helped me to grow and I want to help others to grow. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! Ephesians 4:17 says, "So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking." Paul is telling us something really important here. He actually said that he was insisting on this. When he referred to the Gentiles here it was talking about people who were not saved. This makes sense now. When you are saved you should not live like you used to live. Then Paul said that unsaved people used to live in the futility of their thinking and we shouldn't live that way any more. I am sure when you were saved many things changed in your life and Paul is saying that even our thinking needs to change. The way our thinking changed was when we learned God's ways we accepted them as the truth and we choose to live how God wants us to live.

This is an ongoing process. I am sure there are times when you read something in the Word and it stretches you in the way you have been thinking. We all have that happen and when it happens we need to be thankful that God loves us so much that He is helping us to think better and He is helping us to live better.

Want some examples? Luke 6:38 says, "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you." God tells us to be givers and He promises to bless us. Look at Ephesians 4:32, "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." We need to forgive others just like God forgave us.

Before we gave our lives to Jesus we were darkened in our understanding, we were separated from the life of God and our hearts were hardened. To put it bluntly WE WERE LOST! Thank God that Jesus came to seek and to save the lost. Now that we are saved we need to read the Word, we need to believe the Word, we need to renew our minds to the Word and we need to live the Word.

If there is ever a time when God speaks to you and you are not sure what you think about what He is saying to you let me give you some advice: Accept what He is saying and do what He says. He is always right.

Paul said unsaved people have hardened hearts. When you were saved God gave you a new heart and a new spirit. Ezekiel 36:26 says, "I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh." Thank God! Keep your heart open to Jesus and all that He has for you. He will give you life and life in abundance.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for all the good work You are doing in my life. I want to keep growing and I want to willingly submit to You and Your ways. I know that You have given me a new life and I want to have all the life and life in abundance that You have for me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! Paul is continuing to describe people who are not saved. Ephesians 4:19 says, "Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, and they are full of greed."

I know that Paul wrote this literally thousands of years ago but doesn't it sound like it was describing the days that we are living in? Here are some more verses that Paul wrote in 2 Timothy 3:1-5, "But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days. People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with such people." In these verses Paul said that these things describe how people would be living *in the last days*. I don't know if these are the last days or not but I know we are closer than when Paul wrote this. Take a moment and read these verses again slowly and see how they fit today.

Now, Look at what Paul ended with. Have nothing to do with such people. Now we are supposed to be reaching out to people, so how does that line up with what Paul said here. Remember Jesus spent time with sinners. Here's the balance. Jesus spent time with sinners but they didn't influence Him. He influenced them. So, let your life influence others but don't let them draw you down.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for delivering me from the world and from worldly ways. I know that You are manifesting life and life in abundance to me. Help me to be strong enough to influence others. I want Your light and Your truth to be evident for everyone to see. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Paul had some more to say right along these lines. Ephesians 4:20-24 say, "That, however, is not the way of life you learned when you heard about Christ and were taught in Him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness."

Thank God we are saved! Thank God that He is constantly teaching us how to live Godly lives. "Put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds." Haven't you put off some old things? Now, we are being made new in the attitude of our minds. As we study the Word, believe the Word and renew our minds to the Word we will live like God wants. We play a part in this process, but know that Jesus is with you and He will always help you.

Look at this phrase: We are **created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.** Does that stretch you in your thinking? If it does, I suppose that is understandable, but don't let that keep you from *believing it*. Choose to believe the Word. Let Jesus and the Word help you. Don't ever settle for less.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for starting Your good work in my life. I know that You are always helping me to do good and to grow in You and Your ways. I choose to believe Your Word! I am never going to settle for anything less than Your best in my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! Ephesians 4:25 starts with this word: **Therefore.** When you read the verse *therefore* it is good to look back at what was written before it. Ephesians 4:24 says, "**Put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.**" By saying *therefore*, God is saying we are new creations in Jesus and that should *therefore* do the things listed next.

Ephesians 4:25 says, "Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body." As believers we should put off falsehood and always speak the truth.

Verse 26 says, "In your anger do not sin: Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry." Verse 27 says, "And do not give the devil a foothold." Do you think the Word is saying that anger can give the devil a foothold in our lives? If you think that is what the Word is saying, you are right.

Paul goes on. Verse 28 says, "Anyone who has been stealing must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with their own hands, that they may have something to share with those in need." There is something here that I want to comment on and then we will see some more tomorrow. Anyway, this verse says we are to work, doing something useful with their own hands, that they may have something to share with those in need. Have you ever thought about part of why you work is so you will have something to give? At Creative I often remind people that you are blessed to be a blessing. Paul might also say that we work so we can share with others.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for Your ongoing work in my life. I want to keep my life completely open to You and completely closed to the devil. I know that doing what the Word says will do those things. Help me to really believe what You are speaking to me and help me to choose to believe and help me to live how You say I should. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! Paul was writing to believers that really needed to do the things he was saying *and* we are believers who really need to do the things he was saying.

Ephesians 4:29 says, "Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen."

There are clearly two parts of this versus. First, there are things that should be eliminated from the way we as believers talk. I am sure some people read this and conclude that we shouldn't curse and swear, and I agree we shouldn't be cursing and swearing, but Paul went beyond that. **Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths.** There are things that may not be cursing and swearing but they are still unwholesome.

Secondly, Paul talks about the kinds of things we should be speaking. We should be speaking things that are *helpful*, *building others up and beneficial*. We should be speaking life.

Here are a couple of things that will help you to speak life. First, of all we need to be full of life. Jesus said that He came to give us life and life in abundance. As we embrace the life Jesus has for us we will speak life. Secondly, the more Word we have the more we will speak life. The Bible says that we speak from the abundance in our hearts. So be full of Life and the Word.

Prayer: Lord, I want the fact that I am saved to be evident in every aspect of my life. Help my to words reveal that I am a born-again believer. Please speak to me if I am ever about to speak any unwholesome things and help me to stop. I want to be full of Your life and Your Word so I will build others up with my words. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

If He does speak to you about getting rid of some of these things here are two things that are important for you to remember. First, He spoke that to you because He loves you. Secondly, He will help you to deal with those things. Thank God.

Those are bad things that need to go, and next Paul lists some good things that should be evident in our lives as Christians. "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." If God is speaking you about some things from these verses, know the same two things that I already wrote to you are still true. First, God is speaking that to you because He loves you and secondly, He will help you to develop these things in your life. Thank God!

Prayer: Lord, I am amazed at how You speak to me from Your Word. Help me to know that You speak to me because You love me and help me to remember that You will always help me to do what You want me to do. I want to live more fully for You and I want my life to be a good witness. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

And so He condemned sin in the flesh, in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit." There is no condemnation for us because Jesus died on the cross for our sins and we have accepted Him as our Lord and Savior.

Now, when we believe in Jesus we will surely do many other good things because we are now living for Him but it all starts when we believe in Jesus. A person could do lots of good things and still be lost if they didn't accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

Now, look at Galatians 5:22-23, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law." This is a wonderful list. Saved people live like these things. These are things that should be growing in our lives.

To continue, Galatians 5:24-25 say, "Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit." Because we have given our lives to Jesus the things in verses 19-21 should be gone or at least decreasing in our lives and the things in verses 22-23 should be manifesting and growing in our lives.

Thank God for the Holy Spirit. He is always with us and He will always help us to grow into the things of God. Let's **keep in step with the Spirit.** 

Prayer: Lord, help me to live like You want. I know that Your ways are always right. Help me to eliminate the acts of the flesh and help me to grow in the fruit of the Spirit. I thank You for the progress I have already made and I want to keep growing. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes?" Have you ever met someone who seemed to be consumed with worry? In this verse, Jesus is tell us to not worry.

In the next verse, Jesus said, "Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?" Think about birds. They don't sow, they don't reap and they don't store up. God takes care of them.

Then Jesus says some more. "Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?" This is interesting. Doctors tell us that worrying can even shorten our lives.

Look at what Peter wrote in 1 Peter 5:7, "Cast all your anxiety on Jesus because He cares for you." I am sure you know that when Peter referred to anxiety he was talking about worries too. Did you notice why Peter said we should cast our anxieties and worries on Jesus? He said we should do that because Jesus cares for us.

When we know that Jesus cares for us, we can have confidence that He will meet our needs. When we know that Jesus laid His life down for us and died on the cross to save us, we can surely know that He continues to care for us and we should know that He will meet our needs.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me. I know that You also care about every aspect of my life. Help me to cast my worries on You. Help me to know that You will continue meeting my needs like You always have. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 16-18 Ephesians 1

Praise the Lord! Let's continue the story we started with yesterday. Matthew 6:28-29 say, "And why do you worry about clothes? See how the flowers of the field grow. They do not labor or spin. Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these." Jesus is still speaking to us about trusting Him and not worrying.

In verse 30, Jesus said, "If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will He not much more clothe you—you of little faith?" God takes care of the flowers, the grass and the birds - shouldn't we know that He will take care of us? Now, Jesus mentioned faith. We had faith to be saved and we should have faith that He will take care of our needs.

Verse 31 says, "So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?'" Right after Jesus talked to them about faith, He said, So do not worry. Faith and worry are opposites and Jesus is speaking the Word to us to help us to have faith. Romans 10:17 says, "Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the Word about Christ." Faith comes by hearing the message of the Word. The word translated hearing is a word that talks about hearing and hearing and hearing.

So, Jesus wants us to stop worrying and He wants us to have faith. He is giving us the Word to help us.

Prayer: Lord, I know that I was saved when I put my faith in You. I also know that I am called to live by faith. Help me to learn from Your Word and help me to embrace the faith that comes from hearing and hearing Your Word. Help me to believe that You will always meet all my needs. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
