Scripture Reading: Exodus 27-28 Matthew 21:23-46

Praise the Lord! Look at Titus 1:1, **“Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ to further the faith of God’s elect and their knowledge of the truth that leads to godliness.”** This is Paul’s opening statement in the book of Titus and there is sure a lot in this one verse. I don’t want you to miss anything here.

Paul started off by saying he was a *servant of God*. Now, I know that he also said that he was an *apostle of Jesus*, but I think it is significant that he first said he was a *servant*. Look at what Jesus said in Matthew 23:11-12, **“The greatest among you will be your servant. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.”** Jesus really meant what He said here. The way to be great in the Kingdom of God is to be a servant. Here’s another verse on this. Mark 9:35 says, **“Sitting down, Jesus called the Twelve and said, “Anyone who wants to be first must be the very last, and the servant of all.””** I want to move on, but know that Jesus meant what He said and Paul evidently believed what Jesus said.

Now, notice what Paul said about why he was writing. He wrote **to further the faith of God’s elect and their knowledge of the truth that leads to godliness.** Paul wrote to help God’s people have faith and knowledge of the truth that would help them to live fully for God. Aren’t you thankful for the Word? I am sure you are thankful for the Word because you are studying God’s Word every day.

Be thankful for the Word and for those God has brought into your life to help you to grow in faith and in the Word.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for teaching me Your truth every day. I thank You for those who serve me and I ask You to help me to serve others as You give me opportunities. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Exodus 29-30 Matthew 22:1-22

Praise the Lord! Titus 1:1-2 say, **“Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ to further the faith of God’s elect and their knowledge of the truth that leads to godliness—in the hope of eternal life, which God, who does not lie, promised before the beginning of time. . .”**

Before you were saved you were dead in your sins. When you gave your life to Jesus, He saved you and He gave you life right now. In John 10:10 Jesus said, **“The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.”** Jesus came to give you *life and life in abundance*. This is talking right now. Thank God and there is more. When you were saved, Jesus also gave you *Eternal life*.

In our verses from Titus, Paul referred to *the hope of eternal life*. Listen, God started His good work in your life and He is going to finish it. You are going to make it in this life and you are going to be with Jesus *forever*. That should give you hope. I know you have probably been through some hard things, but Jesus was always with you and He brought you through them. Thank God and let those things give you hope.

Paul told us that God doesn’t lie. That might seem like a strange point but it is relevant. We need to believe all of God’s promises and not doubt. God doesn’t lie. Even the things He **promised before the beginning of time** are still valid. God knows everything and if He wasn’t going to keep His promises He would not have made them.

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful for the life that I have in You now and I know that I am going to enjoy life with You forever. Help me to know that You never lie and help me to believe all of Your promises. I don’t ever want to miss out on anything You have for me. I want all the life and life in abundance that You have for me. In Jesus’ Name, Amen.

In verse three Paul, mentioned that he had been called to preach the Word of God. Thank God for the people who are called to preach the Word. I know that each of us can study and learn on our own, and we certainly need to do that, but know that God also uses others to preach and teach you from God’s Word. Value those who have diligently and consistently taught you the Word.

Ephesians 4:11-13, **“So Christ Himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip His people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.”**

God wants you to **become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ** and He gave people to teach you and to help you.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for teaching me the Word. I also thank You for the people You have brought into my life to help me to know You and Your ways. Scripture Reading: Exodus 34-36 Matthew 23:1-22

Praise the Lord! Psalms 24:1 says, **"The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it. . ."** Genesis 1:1 says, **"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."** There are people who think everything just happened. We know that God created all things.

Notice that this verse not only says God created the world. It says He also created **all who live in it**. That means God created us too. Thank God that we know this. God is all powerful. He was powerful enough to create you and He is surely powerful enough to take care of you.

Verse 2 says, **"For He founded it on the seas and established it on the waters."** Verse 3 says, **"Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in His holy place?"** God created all things, including us. He has opened the way for us to come unto Him.

Verse 4 tells us who can draw near to Him and be in His presence. **"The one who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not trust in an idol or swear by a false god."** Now I hasten to remind you that you are clean and pure because Jesus made you clean and pure when you gave your life to Him. Thank God. 2 Corinthians 5:17 says, **"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"** As born-again believers we are *in Christ*. The old is *gone and the new is here*. We are new creations in Jesus. We could have never been good enough to be saved but Jesus paid the price for us to be saved.

Prayer: Lord, thank You, Jesus, for saving me. I know there was no way for me to be saved on my own and I know that You became the Way. Matthew 23:23-39

Look at what Jesus said in Matthew 6:33, **“But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.”** I know I give you this verse a lot, but today we are being told that we will be blessed when we *seek Jesus and His Kingdom*.

Prayer: Lord, thank You Lord for saving me and thank You for blessing me in so many ways. Thank You for giving me a new heart and a new spirit. I choose to seek You first and I am never going to quit. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Just in case you need to hear this one more time, look at verse 10, **“Who is He, this King of glory? The Lord Almighty—He is the King of glory.”** He is the King of glory! He is all mighty and He is the King of glory.

Matthew 25:34 says, **“Then the King will say to those on His right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by My Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world.’”** Jesus is the King and we have entered into His Kingdom. We are blessed!

Scripture Reading: Leviticus 1-3

Matthew 24:23-51

Praise the Lord! Jesus often used illustrations to reveal truth to us. Look at John 15:1, **"I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener."** I am sure you are like me and when you read that you thought about a vineyard that you have either seen for real or in a picture. That is what we should do but we also need to think deeper than that. Jesus wants us to think about us being in this picture.

As Jesus said, He is the vine and the Father is the gardener. Now, look at verse 2, **"He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit He prunes so that it will be even more fruitful."** When we realize and remember that Jesus is telling this story to help us to know about really important things so we can see a lot more.

God wants us to grow and He wants us to produce fruit. So, God works in our lives to eliminate things that keep us from being productive. Think about when you were first saved. Were there things in your life that God wanted eliminated? There were sure a lot of things in my life that need to be pruned. Here's a really good truth. God knows what He is doing. When He wants something pruned from your life it is for your own good. I hope you have realized that and I hope you remember it because this process goes on.

Verse 3 says, **"You are already clean because of the Word I have spoken to you."** Thank God for your salvation, but now God wants you to be fruitful. Giving your life to Jesus and being saved is wonderful! Can I get an, "Amen!"? But it isn't all there is.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for all the work that You have done in my life. I know that You want me to bear fruit. Help me to know that Your work in my life is good and help me to know that Your ways are always right. I want to keep growing and I really do want to produce fruit. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Leviticus 4-6 Matthew 25:1-30

Praise the Lord! John 15:4 says, **“Remain in Me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in Me.”** We could only be saved by giving our lives to Jesus. Now that we are saved we need to *remain in Him* and we need to bear fruit for Him and His ways.

Jesus wants us to get this truth so much that He makes this point several times. John 15:5 says, **“I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.”** Look at what Paul said in Philippians 3:1, **“Further, my brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord! It is no trouble for me to write the same things to you again, and it is a safeguard for you.”** Paul knew it was good for them to make some points over and over, I know that it is good for me to make some points over and over and Jesus knew that it was good for Him to make some points over and over.

Are you getting the point? God wants you to be saved and now that you are saved He wants you to bear fruit. When we remain in Jesus we will bear fruit. If we don't remain in Him look at John 15:6, **“If you do not remain in Me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned.”** Let's be sure to remain in Jesus. Verse 7 says, **“If you remain in Me and My words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.”** That is an amazing promise and Jesus meant what He said. The word *remain* is used 8 times in 4 verses.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me. I choose to remain in You and I choose to keep growing and producing fruit for You. Help me to know if there are things that need to be pruned from my life. I want to be fruitful for You. Thank You for Your love and thank You for Your patience. I hear what You are speaking to me right now. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Leviticus 7-9 Matthew 25:31-46

Praise the Lord! Look at John 15:7, **“If you remain in Me and My Words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.”** Isn't this an amazing verse? Can you believe this?

Well, look at Matthew 7:7-8, **“Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.”** Can you believe this?

Now, look at 1 John 5:13-15, **“I write these things to you who believe in the Name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life. This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of Him.”**

These verses make two points that are vitally important. First, God's promise to answer when our prayers are made for those who are born-again believers. Answered prayers are for those who have given their lives to Him and who are living for Him. Second, our prayers must be in accordance with His will.

How do we know if are praying in accordance with with His will? We know it by knowing the Word. When we are born-again children of God and when we know God's will, according to His Word, we can and should pray with great confidence because He promises to answer our prayers.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for saving me and thank You for teaching me Your will through Your Word. I also thank You for inviting me to ask, to seek and to knock knowing that You promise that I will receive, that I will find and that doors will be opened to me. I choose to believe and I choose to never quit. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Leviticus 10-12 Matthew 26:1-19

Praise the Lord! Do you have a red letter Bible? Red letter Bibles print all the Words that Jesus said in red. I just looked at Matthew 7 and *every word is red*.

Yesterday, we covered John 15:7 and Jesus said, **"If you remain in Me and My Words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you."**

Now look at what Jesus said next in verse 8, **"This is to My Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be My disciples."** Jesus was talking about our being born-again, living fully for Him, praying in line with His Word and having our prayers answered.

Now, He says that we should *bear much fruit*. When we are His, when we pray and have answers to our prayers that is bearing fruit. Look at what Jesus said we should should pray for in Matthew 6:9-10, **"This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your Name, Your Kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.""**

Now, first of all I want to point out that we can surely know we are praying God's will when we pray what Jesus tells us to pray. Having said that, can you see that as God answers these prayers it will all be His will being done and we will be *showing ourselves as His disciples*? So, let's be doers of the Word and not hearers only. Jesus said that when we live this way we will be on solid ground in Matthew 7:24, **"Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock."**

Prayer: Lord, I pray for Your Kingdom to come and for Your will to be done on earth as it is in heaven. Help me to remember this way of praying when I don't know what else to pray. I know that Your Kingdom coming and Your will being done is what I should pray for. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Matthew 26:20-54

Praise the Lord! Yesterday, we looked at how Jesus told us to pray in Matthew 6:9-10, **“This, then, is how you should pray: “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your Name, Your Kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.””**

Here is some more about God’s Kingdom that you can incorporate into your prayers. In Romans 14:17 Paul wrote this, **“For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.”**

I am sure you are like me and there are times when we know we should pray about someone or some situation and we don’t know enough about the situation to know how to pray. Well, Jesus told us to pray for His Kingdom to come and for His will to be done and now we know that His Kingdom is a matter of *righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit*.

Here’s an example. If I wanted to pray for you and all those who are doing these devotions, I could pray: “Lord, I pray for Your Kingdom to come for your will to be done in all my brothers and sisters lives. I pray for them to have and to walk in righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit! I pray they will be strong in You and I pray that they will always bear fruit for You.”

Pray, believe and don’t quit. Matthew 7:8 says, **“For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.”**

Prayer: Lord, help me to pray more. I know that You promise to hear and answer my prayers. Help me to believe. I invite You to speak to me about people and situations that I need to pray for. I want to be faithful to do all that You have for me to do. In Jesus’ Name, Amen.

Did you see it? Jesus loves us *just as the Father loved Him!* If you need to read it some more to see that is what it really says, make the effort and take the time. This is amazing.

Now, I want to share a verse that I will write some more about in a couple of days but I want to give it you now. John 15;11 says, "**These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.**"

Jesus told you that He loves you *just as the Father loved Him* and so that *His joy may be in you and so that your joy may be full.* Jesus said that *His joy* may be in us. And Jesus said that *our joy may be full.* The word *full* here is very special. This the kind of full that if you had a glass of water that was *full* and I mean so full that it was right up the rim but there is even more. If you jiggled it a little and some ran out when you held it back up *it would still be full.* We are blessed to be loved and we are blessed to have the joy of the Lord.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for loving me and for saving me. Help me to have a greater understanding of Your love. I know that everything good in my life is because of You. I know that You only have good things for me and I know that a greater revelation of Your love will be good for me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Praise the Lord! John 15:9-10 say, **“As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you. Now remain in My love. If you keep My commands, you will remain in My love, just as I have kept My Father’s commands and remain in His love.”**

Here’s what we have seen and talked about. Jesus loves us like the Father loves Him. That is such an amazing truth. By the way, in case anyone ever wants to try to argue with this, let me quickly remind us all that Jesus said this and so we know it is true.

Now, on to verse 10. We are told to keep His commands. Look at what Jesus said in Matthew 22:36-40, **“Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?” Jesus replied: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.”**

We need to love God and we need to love people. That is living like Jesus wants us to live.

Now, would you like to know how much we are to do those things? Jesus said, we should do those things **just as I have kept My Father’s commands and remain in His love.** Thank God that He will help us in all these things. Look at what Paul said in Philippians 4:13, **“I can do all this through him who gives me strength.”**

Prayer: Lord, thank You for speaking to me from Your Word today. I choose to believe You and I choose to believe Your Word. Help me to love You and help me to love others. In Jesus’ Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Leviticus 18-19 Matthew 27:32-66

Praise the Lord! Yesterday, we looked at John 15:10, **“If you keep My commands, you will remain in My love, just as I have kept My Father’s commands and remain in His love.”**

In verse 11, Jesus tells us why He told us those things. **“I have told you this so that My joy may be in you and that Your joy may be complete.”** Did you catch what Jesus said? He said He told us about living like God wants us to live (by loving Him and by loving people) **so that My joy may be in you and that Your joy may be complete.**

This word *complete* is like the *complete* we talked about a couple of days ago. Jesus’ *complete* joy never runs out and that is what Jesus wants us to have. Can you say, “Thank You, Jesus!”?

Look at Romans 15:13, **“May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.”** God has *hope, joy and peace* for us. By the *power of the Holy Spirit* these wonderful things can and will *abound to us in hope!*

1 John 1:4 says, **“And we are writing these things so that our joy may be complete.”** God had the Word written so you could have complete joy. God had the Word protected for thousands of years so you could have complete joy. God has you studying His Word every day so you can have complete joy. God loves you that much!

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful that I have given my life to You and I am so thankful for all the blessing You have for me. I don’t ever want to miss out on anything You have for me. Thank You for loving me and for giving me hope, joy and peace. Thank You for revealing all these wonderful things through Your Word. I believe! In Jesus’ Name, Amen.

Mark 7:1-13

Praise the Lord! I hope you have been doing the Scripture Readings I put on here every day. If you do them every day, you will be able to read the whole Bible in a year. I commend you for that. If you haven't been doing them every day, I want to encourage you to start. Being in God's Word is vital for you and doing it will help you to grow in Him.

Now, look at something from the Scripture Reading in Mark 7 for today. Mark 7:8 says, "**You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to human traditions.**" Jesus was talking to some people who were more interested in holding on to the *traditions of men* more than the Word of God.

This goes right along with verse 13, "**Thus you nullify the Word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And you do many things like that.**" Jesus said they were *nullifying the Word of God*. The word *nullify* means to invalidate, to make of no use or value and to cancel out. If that sounds serious, it is.

They were making the Word of God invalid, of no use, of no value and they were canceling it out. What were they doing that did all these things? They were letting traditions and the ways men do things be more important than what the Word of God says.

Now, I know you are not doing these things but I have to tell you that the way to make sure we don't do them is to really know what the Word says. So, keep reading and studying the Word and be a doer of the Word and not a hearer only.

Prayer: Lord, I am thankful for Your Word. Thank You for making me able to read the Word, to Study the Word and to put Your Word into practice. Thank You for promising me that when I know Your Word and do what Your Word says, I will be blessed. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Mark 7:14-37

Praise the Lord! Mark 7:32-35 say, **“There some people brought to Him a man who was deaf and could hardly talk, and they begged Jesus to place His hand on him. After He took him aside, away from the crowd, Jesus put His fingers into the man’s ears. Then He spit and touched the man’s tongue. He looked up to heaven and with a deep sigh said to him, “Ephphatha!” (which means “Be opened!”). At this, the man’s ears were opened, his tongue was loosened and he began to speak plainly.”**

Praise God! Jesus healed this man. Look at Hebrews 13:8, **“Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.”** Jesus was the Healer, Jesus is still the the Healer and He will always be the Healer! That’s what the Word says and thank God, we believe the Word! Amen?

There are several interesting details in the account of this miracle and I want to point out some things and write to you about them today. People brought **a man who was deaf and could hardly talk** to Jesus. This man was in need and *they brought him to Jesus*. This was the right thing for them to do. When we have needs we should *take them to Jesus*.

Now look at this. Jesus said, Be Opened! **At this, the man’s ears were opened, his tongue was loosened and he began to speak plainly.** He was healed! Thank God. Did you notice how much he was healed? His **ears were opened, his tongue was loosened he began to speak plainly.** Jesus healed him completely. Thank God. Hebrews 13:8 still says, **“Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.”** Believe it.
