The Lord watches over you— the Lord is your shade at your right hand; the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night. The Lord will keep you from all harm—He will watch over your life; the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore."** Praise God!

In John 10:10, Jesus said, **“The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.”** The works of the flesh produce the bad things that we read about in Galatians 5. Jesus and the Holy Spirit produce the fruit of the Spirit and that is all good.

**Scripture Reading: Job 38-39
Acts 15:1-21**

Praise the Lord! Look at what Jesus said in John 14:7. Actually, let me ask you a question first. Do you really believe what Jesus says? Ok, in John 14:7 Jesus said, **“If you really know Me, you will know My Father as well. From now on, you do know Him and have seen Him.”** We know Jesus and He said we know the Father just like we know Him.

Now, you might not be having a hard time with what I just said but Philip had a problem with it. Look at verse 8, **“Philip said, ‘Lord, show us the Father and that will be enough for us.’”** Jesus said if we know Him then we know the Father. Philip said, “Lord, show us the Father!”

Ok, as you might expect I am going somewhere with these things. Philip should have believed what Jesus said and we should believe what Jesus says to us. Want an example? Look at what Jesus said in John 10:27, **“My sheep hear My voice; I know them, and they follow Me.”** Jesus said that we hear His voice. When I have shared this verse I have often had people come up to me and say, “I don’t hear His voice.” I ask them if they are saved and they say that they are. Well, Jesus said His sheep hear His voice.

Look at what Jesus said to Phillip next in verse 9, “Jesus answered: **“Don’t you know Me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen Me has seen the Father. How can you say, ‘Show us the Father’?”**”

Prayer: Lord, help me to believe what You say. I choose to believe what You say more than what I think. Help me to believe and help me to say what I believe in line with the Word. I choose to say that I hear Your voice. I do pray for You to teach me more about hearing Your voice, but I start from the position of knowing what the Word says and believing it. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Job 40-42 Acts 15:22-41

Praise the Lord! I suppose someone might be wondering why I am spending so much time on Jesus talking to Philip about believing what He said. Well, let me write that sentence again and add a little bit to it. I am spending so much time on Jesus talking to Philip (*and us*) about believing what He said.

We need to believe what Jesus says to us. When we read the Word we need to believe it. I am spending time on this because Jesus spent time on it. Believe me, Philip needed it and we need it.

Ok, look at the things Jesus said next. John 14:10-11 say, **“Don’t you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in Me? The Words I say to you I do not speak on My own authority. Rather, it is the Father, living in Me, who is doing His work. Believe Me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; or at least believe on the evidence of the works themselves.”**

Jesus told Philip to believe in the things He was saying on the evidence of the work that Philip had seen Jesus doing. Well, let me apply this to you and me. We should believe in the things Jesus says based on the evidence of the work Jesus has done in our lives! Hasn’t Jesus saved you? That is a miracle. Hasn’t Jesus protected you? That is a miracle. Hasn’t Jesus provided for you? That is a miracle. Now, I could go on and on but I think you are getting my point. Jesus has worked in all of our lives and the evidence of those things should help us to believe that He speaks to us and we hear His voice.

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful for all that You have done in my life. I believe in those things and I believe everything You say to me. I believe that I hear Your voice. I believe that You have started a good work in my life and I believe You are going to finish Your good work in my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Christ Jesus is the One who died—more than that, who was raised—Who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.”** Jesus is interceding for us. I know of some people who are powerful in prayer and I sometimes ask them to pray about things and I have confidence in their prayers, but I have even more confidence in Jesus’ prayers!

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful that You have saved me and I am thankful for all that You have done in my life. I am also thankful for the things You say about my life. I choose to believe and I am so thankful that You are praying for me. I choose to believe that Your prayers are being answered. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Now, I feel like I need to add some to this wonderful promise. I am not taking away from what Jesus said but look at what 1 John 5:13-15 say, **“I write these things to you who believe in the Name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life. This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of Him.”**

God promises to answer our prayers when we are praying *in accordance with His will*. This is so important. Listen, if I was praying for something that is not God’s will I would not want Him to answer that prayer.

How do we know God’s will? We know God’s will by the Word. John 15:7 says, **“If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.”**

Prayer: Lord, thank You for all that You are teaching me through Your Word. I want to know Your Word and I want to pray in accordance with Your will. I want to abide in You and I want Your Word to abide in me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scripture Reading: Psalms 7-9 Acts 17:1-15

Praise the Lord! Well, look at the next verse in John 14. Verse 15 says, **"If you love me, keep my commands."** We have seen a lot of wonderful things in John 14 and I think this is the shortest verse we have seen but it is powerful. Can I get an "Amen!"?

Later in John's life he wrote letters that God chose to include in the Word. Look at what John wrote many years later. 1 John 2:3-6 say, **"We know that we have come to know Him if we keep His commands. Whoever says, 'I know Him,' but does not do what He commands is a liar, and the truth is not in that person. But if anyone obeys His Word, love for God is truly made complete in them. This is how we know we are in Him: Whoever claims to live in Him must live as Jesus did."**

We can know that we love God when we live like He wants us to live. Now, I want you to take this truth and apply it in your life first. You see, some people take truths like this and run off judging everyone else. We need to apply this to our selves first. Look at how John said these things, **This is how we know we are in Him."**

If we love Jesus and know Him, we will obey what He says and the truth will set us free. Now, look at the last thing written here. **Whoever claims to live in Him must live as Jesus did.** That is an amazing statement. Think about how Jesus lived. He loved God and He obeyed God in all things and that is how we must live.

Prayer: Lord, I do love You and I want my life to show it. Help me to know Your ways and help me to put what You teach me into action in my life. I know that Your calling on my life needs to affect every area of my life and I know that I should always live in line with You and Your Word. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Look at what the Word reveals to us in John 14:26-27, **“But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My Name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; My peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.”**

Have you ever felt like you had lots to learn? Well, Jesus said that the Father will send the Holy Spirit to help us. He also said that the Holy Spirit **will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.** Thank God for the Holy Spirit. Look at what Jesus said in John 16:7-11, **“But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you. John 16:12-14 say, “I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on His own; He will speak only what He hears, and He will tell you what is yet to come. He will glorify Me because it is from Me that He will receive what He will make known to you.”**

Jesus said that it was for our good that He went away. He has sent the Holy Spirit to reveal God’s will to us and He will help us to live for Jesus.

Look at the three things that are mentioned in these three verses other than *God's love endures for ever*. In verse 1 we are told to, **Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good**. God is good. Thank God for his goodness. If you are sometimes amazed at his goodness for you know that He is always good!

In verse 2, we are told to, **Give thanks to the God of gods**. Notice that when other so called *gods* are mentioned the word is not capitalized. That is because they are not real *gods* like the **GOD** we know and love. In verse 3, we are told to **Give thanks to the Lord of lords**.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for speaking to me today. I thank You for Your goodness, I thank You that You are the only true God and I thank You that You are Lord of lords. I know that Your love endures forever and I want to give You thanks forever as well. Help me to remember all these wonderful things about You and help me to give thanks more. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

So those who rely on faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.”**

Do you have faith in God? If yes, these verses reveal that you are a child of Abraham. Since that is true, look at this statement, **So those who rely on faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.** Abraham was blessed because he was a man of faith and by faith we are children of Abraham and we are blessed too. Doesn't being blessed by faith sound good to you? Well, it is good to be blessed by faith and there is even more.

These verses start off by saying, **Abraham “believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness.”** We believe God and we are children of Abraham. Now, don't miss this, *our faith is credited to us as righteousness just like Abraham.* Praise God!

I can even back this up with more Scripture. 2 Corinthians 5:21 says this: **“God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.”** Righteousness is credited to us because we are Abraham's children by faith AND we are righteous because *Jesus was made to be sin for us so we could become the righteousness of God.*

Prayer: Lord, thank You so much for Your Word. There is no way I would ever know, or even dream, that I am righteous but I know it is true because Your Word says it and I believe Your Word. We have **God's abundant provision of grace** and we have the **gift of righteousness**. Praise God! Now, please don't miss that we have those things because Jesus died on the cross for us and because we have accepted Him as our Lord and Savior. We could never earn these, or any other blessing from God. We have them because Jesus paid the price for us to have them.

There is even more. Look at this. Because of God's gift of grace and the gift of righteousness we **reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ!** Our part is to give our lives to Jesus and to believe the Word.

Prayer: Lord, I am so thankful for Your Word and I am so thankful that You are revealing so many wonderful things to me. I choose to believe. I am also thankful for You, Holy Spirit, for helping me to see, to understand and to believe the Word. I don't ever want to miss out on anything You have for me In Jesus' Name, Amen.

One more thing from this verse, **Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you.** We are told to cast our cares on Him *because He cares for you*. Isn’t that good news? He invites us to cast our cares on Him. Believe it and do what He invites you to do.

Prayer: Lord, help me to be humble and help me to trust Your timing. I know that You and Your timing are always right. I also know that You care for me. They will dwell in the parched places of the desert, in a salt land where no one lives."** I think we all agree that this doesn't sound very good. Am I right? These verses describe people who have put all their trust in people and they relied only on what man can do for them. They have turned away from God.

Well, look at what Jeremiah 17:7-9 say **"But blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in Him. They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit."** Praise God! These verses describes people who have put their trust and confidence in God. They will be strong, productive and secure. They may go through some hard things but they will be productive no matter what happens.

Who do you put your trust in? Now I know there are some people who are Godly and we can trust in them, but our ultimate trust and confidence needs to be in God. He is the One who will never let us down and He is the One who can bless us. Let's keep our trust and confidence in God and God alone. He can and will help us eternally.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for always being my Lord and Savior. I want to put my ultimate trust and confidence in You and You alone. I want to bear fruit no matter what is happening around me. Thank You for saving me and for keeping my safe and secure in You. I want Your blessing on my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

God hears and He answers our prayer. This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of Him.”** When we pray His Word we know that He hears us and we know that He answers our prayers. Prayer: Lord, I thank You for speaking to me about prayer right now. Help me to pray more.
